


Step 4

You can change the dimensions of the picture and the type of lightning before drawing.






Hold the right mouse button and drag a colour onto another to copy it.



You can similarly drag colours from the Palette.


Drag with LEFT mouse button to pick a colour.

- Layers will be drawn from the bottom up.


Step 5: Build your custom style

Custom Design




Build Custom Design

Draw your shirt!






Drawing Back of the Shirt

Step 1: Click to Enable
